



Fixed and Flex Routes

Fixed Routes – Traverse City

Fixed-route City Loops are timed routes that operate daily in and around Traverse City.

Flex Routes – Traverse City

Flex routes are timed routes that serve our surrounding Villages and are able to deviate up to ¼ of a mile from the route. Several flex routes are seasonal.

Village Loop – Grand Traverse & Leelanau Counties

Village Loops connect with City Loops at half past the hour at our Hall Street Transfer Station. Connections can be made Monday - Friday between 6:30 - 9:30 am, at 11:30 am, 1:30 pm, and between 3:30 - 7:30 pm. Weekend connections are at 9:30 am, 1:30 pm and 5:30 pm. Village Loops are also able to deviate as flex routes and run daily in the following areas:

Transfers

Valid transfers are accepted between any BATA services. Upcharges may apply.

Accommodations

All BATA Link and most BATA Loop buses are wheelchair accessible. For additional information on accommodations, please contact BATA Dispatch Services.

Flag Stops

Flag stops are allowed along all Village Loop & Flex routes. Call BATA Dispatch Services for more information.

Route Deviations

Village Loop and Flex routes allow deviations up to ¾ of a mile. Call BATA Dispatch Services to schedule a route deviation.

Bike Transport*

Year round bike transport is limited to passenger-loaded, front-mounted racks available on all Loop buses.

Bike-n-Ride*

Bike-n-Ride is a seasonal program that accommodates up to 11 bikes. Visit bata.net for more information.

Village Link

For rural riders unable to access a fixed-route stop, Village Link connects to Village Loop routes for travel to and from Traverse City. BATA Dispatch Services helps riders schedule pick-ups and connections.

City Link

Traditional dial-a-ride services Traverse City and the immediate surrounding area.

Advanced registration through BATA Dispatch Services can be made at BATA transfer stations or by phone during the hours below. Registration within these hours the day prior to travel is required to ensure service.

BATA Fares

Please pay exact fare. If you do not have exact change, you will be issued a change card that is good toward future rides. Change cards will not be exchanged for cash.

Multiple-ride passes are available from the drivers and at BATA's Hall St. and Cass Rd. transfer stations. Please visit bata.net for all fare options.

One-way fares:

Full = \$3.00

Reduced = \$1.50

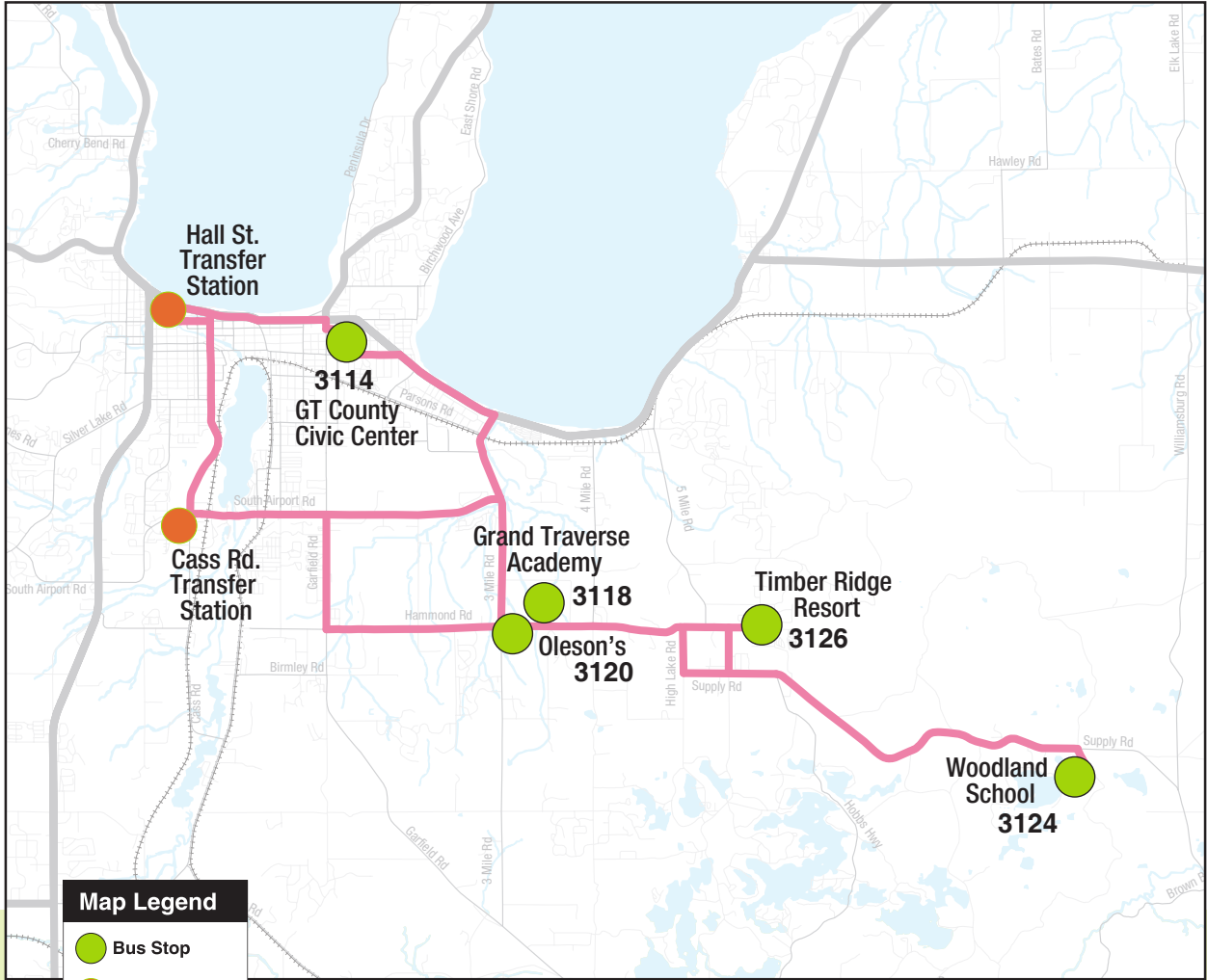
